<p><b>4 Highland Games</b></p>	<p>Agreed target date:- Friday 1<sup>st</sup> June 2017 Liz explained how much the games had been enjoyed by the pupils and the community in the past. The games had been the finals of the athletics and it was generally felt by the room their return would be welcomed, even in a revamped and scaled down form. The Great Big Culloden Academy Bake-Off competition was proposed by Lisa and reinforced by Kerry as a well-attended and competitive event. <u>Free Sideshow's</u> Tarpaulin slide.
