***HEALTH AND SAFETY**– Whilst we welcome seeing pupils cycling to and from school, there is a great risk of injury by not being seen if wearing predominantly black school uniform and not having lights. The Highway Code states *that you should wear light-coloured or fluorescent clothing which helps other road users to see you in daylight and poor light, and reflective clothing and/or accessories in the dark. In the dark your cycle MUST have white front and red rear lights. It MUST also be fitted with a rear red reflector.* Some parents have drawn our attention to cyclists weaving through other pupils wearing earphones and then going straight onto the zebra crossing at speed without stopping.
