HEALTH AND SAFETY– Whilst we welcome pupils cycling to and from school, there is a great risk of injury by not being seen if wearing predominantly black school uniform and not having lights. The Highway Code states *that you should wear light-coloured or fluorescent clothing which helps other road users to see you in daylight and poor light, and reflective clothing and/or accessories in the dark. In the dark your cycle MUST have white front and red rear lights. It MUST also be fitted with a rear red reflector.* Some parents have drawn our attention to cyclists weaving through other pupils wearing earphones and then going straight onto the zebra crossing at speed without stopping. Great care should be taken to avoid an accident. **Miss Lomas**

For the Attention of all Pupils - SQA Prelims
