Good afternoon,

Following the update from the Highland Council concerning the two extra In-Service days on the 7th and 8th of June, we have now received confirmation that school transport will run on those two days and we are in a position to proceed with our plans to bring pupils in to complete their scheduled assessments. In an effort to minimise assessment clashes for pupils over the two days there have been a couple of changes to original times. Should your son/daughter have a clash, please ask them to contact Mr Weafer (SQA Co-ordinator) so that alternative arrangements can be made.

Details of how the two days will work are shared below:

Scheduled Assessments

We would ask pupils to arrive between 9-9:15am as assessments (with one exception) are due to begin at 9:30am. Only the pupils involved in the subjects listed below are required to come in.

Monday 7th of June

9:30am start

<u>Tuesday 8th of June</u> 9:30am start

Advanced Higher: Chemistry (Mrs Blake) Higher: Chemistry (Mrs Sutherland, Mr Angus & Dr Ledingham) National 5: Physics (all N5 pupils) & Biology (Miss Secker & Miss Hanson)

The assessments will conclude at 11:10am on both mornings, at which point pupils are free to leave the premises and head home.

Bus Services

The bus services will collect pupils at their normal pick up points and at their normal times. The buses will leave Culloden Academy at the usual time at the end of the school day. All of the assessments are scheduled to be completed by 11:10 am. Therefore, if it is possible for you to make alternative arrangements for your son/daughter to be collected from the school you may do so. If they need to wait for the bus service to take them home, they will be provided with a supervised area where they can study for any remaining assessments.

Please note that there will be no canteen service provided on either day.
