What are the saltire awards?

The Saltire Awards are the Scottish Government's way of celebrating, recognising and rewarding the commitment, contribution and achievements of young volunteers in Scotland, aged between 12 and 25.

Young people gain nationally recognised certificates, signed by Scottish Government Ministers, for the different amounts of volunteering they do.

What is volunteering?

The Saltire Awards recognise volunteering that meets the following three clear characteristics:

- It is a free will activity. This means you are doing it because you want to, and no one is forcing you to do it.
- It is not done for financial gain. Volunteering is not a job and you cannot be paid; however, you may have any reasonable expenses covered.
- It is for the benefit of the community, society at large or an individual

Why you might want to volunteer?

- Gain new skills and experience that will look great on your CV and could help you at school and/or work
- Meet new people and make new friends and connections
- Make a difference to individual people, communities and the environment
- Have fun! You will have the chance to get involved in variety of activities that might not have done before

Police Scotland Youth Volunteers How to get involved with the PSYV

Youth Volunteers

Each PSYV group consists of 24 young people aged between 13 and 17 who each give up their own time to volunteer in their communities. As a youth volunteer, you would be expected to complete the PSYV Initial Training Programme which will prepare you for attending local and national volunteering events. The training contains multiple subjects across three units.

- About the programme

- Operational PSYV Training

This training and subsequent local 'sessions' take place at a local venue on a weekly or fortnightly basis. During these sessions, youth volunteers will take part in additional training, educational inputs from the police and partner agencies as well as preparing for upcoming volunteering opportunities.

Eligibility

To become a Youth Volunteer, you must be aged between 13 and 15 and be able to dedicate a minimum of three hours per month for volunteering events. As the programme is oversubscribed across Scotland, you must ensure you are able to attend your local group sessions and be available for volunteering opportunities on a regular basis.

Scottish Youth Parliament

Young people aged 14-25 can stand as a candidate in SYP elections. SYP elections are held in Scotland every two years and will next take place in November 2021.

The Scottish Youth Parliament (SYP) is the democratically elected voice of Scotland's young people. Held every two years, SYP elections will take place between the 8th and 21st of November 2021. The deadline to register to stand for this election has now passed, but young people across Scotland are now able to find out more about the candidates standing in their area or for their National Voluntary Organisation, and in November will be able to cast their votes to choose who will represent them for the next two years.



Scottish Space School Virtual Programme

University of Strathclyde

13 – 17 June 2022

Applications Open Friday 4 February 2022



Following the success of our virtual Scottish Space School programme in June 2021, the University of Strathclyde, in collaboration with Wood Plc, are delighted to be offering the programme again in 2022 for school pupils in S5

Given that restrictions relating to the COVID-19 pandemic still remain in place for the University, the 2022 programme will also be going ahead online and will be running from **Monday 13 – Friday 17 June 2022**.

We have developed an online offering which will provide an opportunity to learn from some of the world's leading figures in space travel, including NASA Astronauts and engineers. There are 100 places available on the programme and we ask that you bring this to the attention of S5 pupils who have a talent for mathematics and physical sciences.

The programme will run throughout the week beginning 13 June 2022 with virtual sessions taking place as follows:

- Monday 13 June 2022: Morning Session: 09:15 – 12:30 Afternoon Session: 14:00 – 15:30
- Tuesday 14 June 2022: Morning Session: 09:15 – 12:30 Afternoon Session: 14:00 – 15:30
- Wednesday 15 June 2022: Morning session: 09:15 – 12:30 Evening session: 18:00 – 19:00*
- Thursday 16 June 2022: Morning session: 09:15 – 12:30 Afternoon session: 14:00 – 15:30
- Friday 17 June 2022: Afternoon session only: 14:00 – 16:00

*The evening session on Wednesday 15 June 2022 is our annual 'Evening with NASA' presentation which will be open to the public to also attend online. Further details will

be published and advertised on our website in due course and we can also circulate the details to yourselves. Throughout the week, participants will hear from staff at the university and Wood Plc who will provide an insight into studying and working in the field of engineering, as well as hearing from colleagues at the NASA Johnston Space Centre. Participants will also take part in a group project throughout the week which they will present to a panel of judges made up of staff from the University, Wood Plc and NASA on the final afternoon with a prize awarded to the winning team. Participants must be able to commit to attending all sessions as listed above

This is aimed primarily at \$4/5/6 pupils considering applying for law at university as well as those looking at jobs in the legal industry more generally. Law Society Scotland recommend teachers sign up and forward on the information to interested pupils. This may also be of interest to college students who can sign up direct. According to MyWoW 11,600 people are employed as solicitors in Scotland, one of 11 roles in the 'Legal and court services' job category. <u>Careersmart</u> suggest a potential 5.7% growth in 'Legal Professionals' employment across the UK between 2021-2027.
