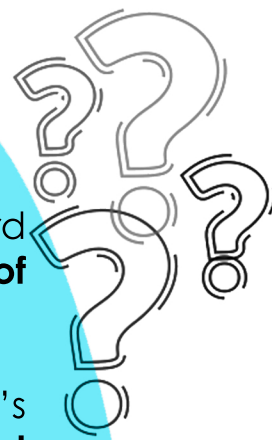


# The Rights Respecting Schools Award

WHAT IS THE RIGHTS RESPECTING AWARD? (RRSA)

The Rights Respecting Schools Award puts **children's rights at the heart of schools** in the UK.

The Award recognises a school's **achievement in putting the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child into practice** within the school and beyond.



WHAT HAVE WE DONE SO FAR?

1. Surveyed all pupils, staff & parents
2. Informed the school we are taking part in the RRSA - via school website, Equalities Magazine, emails, etc.
3. Teaching of RRSA in PSE & other subjects.
4. Started a pupil-led Steering Group in place (RRSA Committee)
