MOBILE PHONES - As mentioned in my assembly, with immediate effect phones are not to be used during class time without the express permission of the teacher. This includes occasions when a pupil is sent on a message or is going to the toilet- the phone must be left in your bag or handed to the teacher for safe keeping. Phones are not permitted in the corridor during block time under any circumstances and if seen, will be confiscated and handed to SMT. I don't expect pupils to be too happy about this but there are sound reasons.

Firstly, pupils are getting out of class, messaging friends who then ask out so that they can go for a wander. That second friend would otherwise have stayed in class and succeeded in their learning and I refuse to stand by while that damage is done to pupil progress. Secondly is the instant impact checking your phone has- it ends the thinking you were doing, distracts you and it can take up to 5

minutes to regain that level of concentration. Phones are great sources of entertainment but they are not a positive influence on thinking, concentrating and learning and we really want you to succeed in your learning. This will be reviewed with Pupil Council Groups in October. - **Dr Vance**
