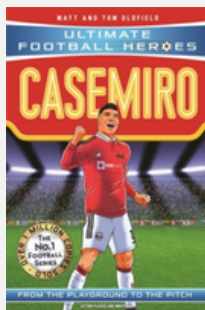
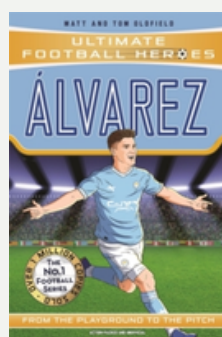
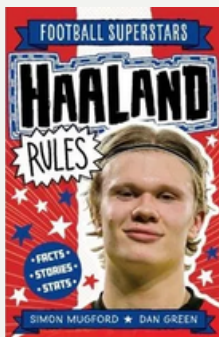
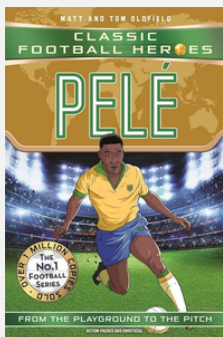


New Book Alerts

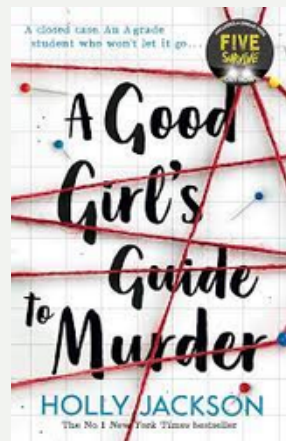

Alvarez, Vinicus Junior and Casemiro will hopefully be in the library before the summer break.

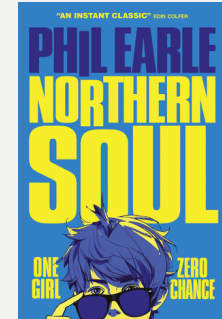
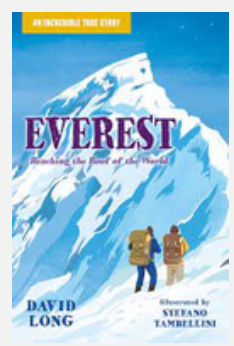
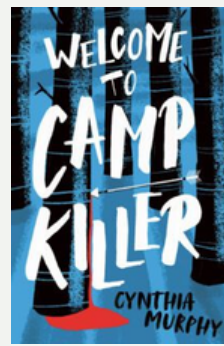


Dyslexia Friendly

These books are popular with many students whether they are dyslexic or not due to the diversity of titles and their short chapters and engaging stories.

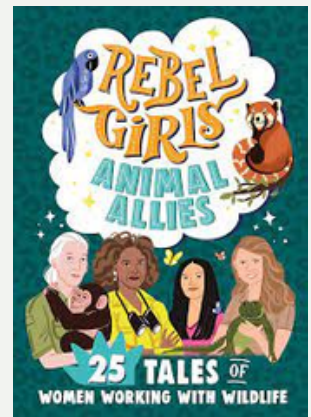
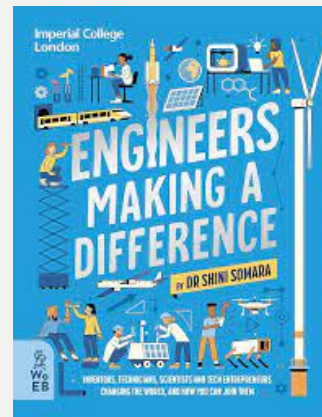
We now have some non-fiction titles in this series as well as the retelling of classics such as *Frankenstein*, *Little Women* and *Pride and Prejudice*.

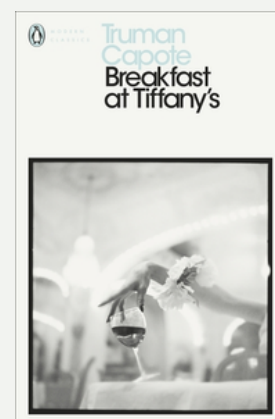
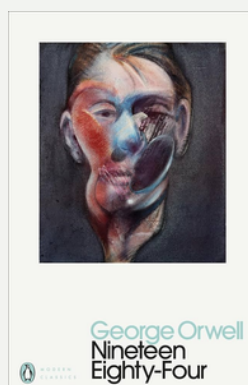
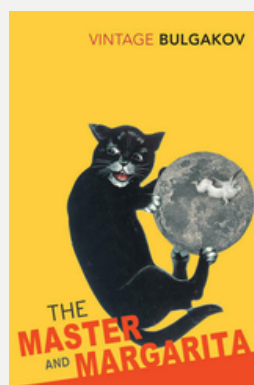
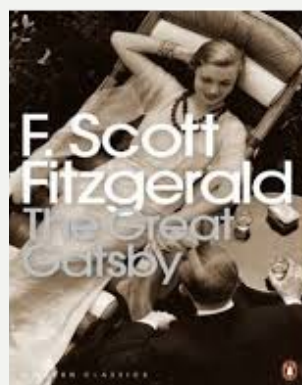
As part of their S1 reading challenge pupils must read a biography on a famous person.

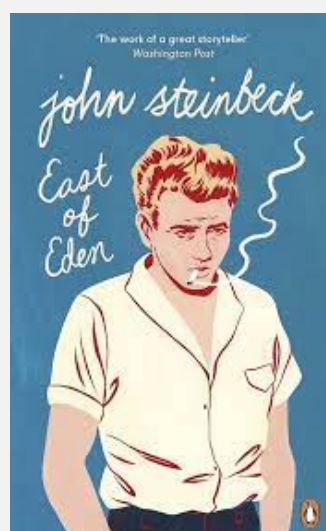
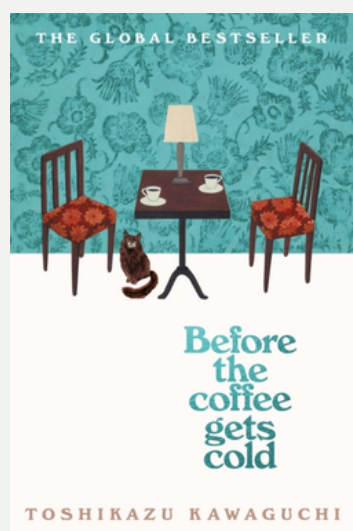


SENIOR FICTION

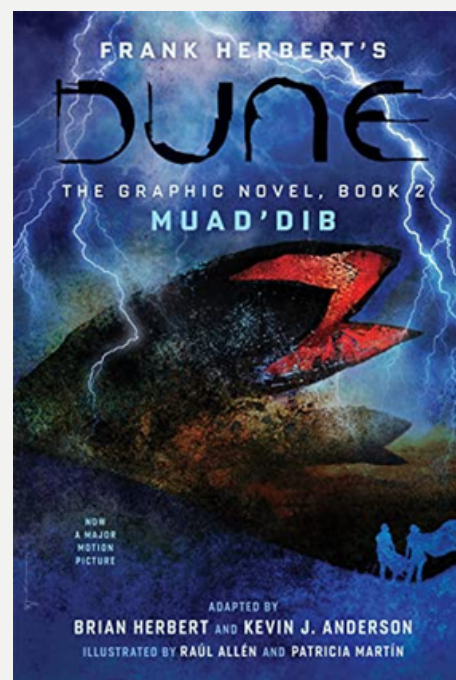


Over time many of our classics have vanished from the library and we have started to replace and expand our collection.
