**FREE SCHOOL MEALS AND CLOTHING GRANTS** - Many Culloden Academy families could be missing out on free school meals and clothing grants. If your child is in S1–S6 and you receive Universal Credit (monthly earned income £850 or less), Income Support, income-based JSA or ESA, Pension Credit (Guaranteed Credit) or certain asylum/immigration support, you can apply for free lunches at school and a £176 school clothing grant for high school pupils. This support is also open to some 16–18 year-olds, families with no recourse to public funds, and families waiting on their first Universal Credit payment.

Free school meal entitlement means your child's lunchtime meal in school is paid for, helping with the cost-of-living and making sure young people can eat well and focus on learning. Clothing grants can help with the cost of the new hoodies, shoes and PE kit so pupils can feel confident and included in school.
